X: Went through two major building programs (sanctuary of 300 seats to 1,500 and 1,500 seats to 5,000).

Q: How do I put together a community-wide musical presentation (Christmas, Easter, Patriotic)?

X: Created, produced and directed major musical presentations such as “The Singing Christmas Tree”, “The Last Supper”, patriotic musicals, etc. with outreaches of over 20,000 people.
